

**CITY OF GRANT
RESOLUTION NO. 2026-20
RESOLUTION ORDERING A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR INDIGO TRAIL N AND
DELLWOOD ROAD CT N TO BE INCLUDED WITH THE 2027 STREET
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City Council ("Council") of the City of Grant, Minnesota ("City") has identified Indigo Trail N and Dellwood Road Ct N as candidate roadways for improvement as part of the 2027 Street Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements may include pavement rehabilitation and reclamation, and other related roadway improvements authorized under Minnesota Statutes, Sections 429.011 to 429.111; and,

WHEREAS, prior to proceeding with such improvements, the City Council desires to obtain a feasibility report evaluating the need for the improvements, alternative rehabilitation methods, estimated project costs, anticipated public benefits, and the properties potentially benefiting from the proposed improvements; and

WHEREAS, the feasibility report will include a geotechnical investigation to evaluate pavement conditions and rehabilitation alternatives, a topographic survey to establish project limits and quantities, and preparation of a feasibility report, with an estimated engineering cost of \$15,000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANT, MINNESOTA:

1. The City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to prepare a Feasibility Report for the proposed improvement of Indigo Trail N and Dellwood Road Ct N as part of the 2027 Street Improvement Project.
2. The Feasibility Report shall evaluate the condition of the existing roadway infrastructure, identify recommended rehabilitation methods, provide estimated project costs, identify properties potentially benefiting from the improvements, and evaluate the feasibility of financing all or a portion of the project through special assessments in accordance with Minnesota Statutes Chapter 429 and the City's Assessment Policy.
3. Upon completion, the Feasibility Report shall be submitted to the City Council for review and consideration at a future meeting.
4. Following receipt and consideration of the Feasibility Report, the City Council may determine whether to proceed with the proposed improvements and, if appropriate, schedule a public hearing pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 429.
