Motion carried with Council Member Lanoux and Sederstrom 6 7 voting nay. 8 0 STAFF AGENDA ITEMS 11 City Engineer, Brad Reifsteck 12 Consideration of Resolution No. 2016-27, Declaring Costs to be Assessed and Ordering 13 Proposed Assessments Keswick Avenue - City Engineer Reifsteck advised following a public 14 hearing, the City Council ordered the public improvements included in the project at the August 2, 15 16 2016 regular Council Meeting. 17 The Council awarded the project at the September 6, 2016 regular Council Meeting to Valley Paving, 18 Inc. of Shakopee, MN with a grand total bid of \$81,749.75. 19 20 Project costs include the construction costs plus all Legal, Engineering and Administration cost 21 associated with the project. There are also rules and procedures for adding items to the agenda. 32 Items can be added to the agenda but the rules have to be followed. 33 34 Council Member Lanoux stated he has asked to put things on the agenda many times and 4H can't use 35 36 the building. He noted the City doesn't follow its own rules. 37 Mayor Carr stated 4H left on their own. He reviewed the League rules and also referred to the by 38 laws relating to items on the agenda and consent agenda. He noted that any changes to the agenda require a motion, second and majority vote. 40 41 Council Member Huber stated the past president of the 4H Club has attended a meeting and advised 42 they moved because of needed kitchen and plumbing facilities. There are two local groups that use 43 the building but it has been restricted to other users because of the video equipment. There are other 44 facilities within the community to hold meetings. It is bad practice to start pulling items or adding 45

To assist the Authorized Representative with the administration of the agreement, Attorney, Nicholas J. Vivian, is appointed as the Authorized Representative's designee.

4. That Iom Carr, the Mayor for the City of Grant, and Kim Points, the City Clerk/Administrator, are authorized to sign the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreements.

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice duly given as required by law, the Grant City Council ("Council") has met, heard and passed upon all objections to the assessment for Keswick Avenue Roadway Improvement Project; and,

WHEREAS, the Project improvement shall include street reconstruction and reclamation, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Sections 429.011 to 429.111; and,

WHEREAS, estimated costs have been calculated for the project and the portion of the cost of such improvement to be assessed against benefited property owners was declared; and,

- 1. Such assessments, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby accepted and shall constitute the special assessment against the lands named therein, and each tract of land therein included is hereby found to be benefited by the proposed improvement in the amount of the assessment levied against it.
- 2. For single family residential properties such assessments shall be payable in equal annual installments extending over a period of 15 years, the first of the installments to be payable on or before the first Monday in January 2017, and shall bear interest at the rate of 4.50 percent from the date of the adoption of this assessment resolution. To each subsequent installment, when due, shall be added interest for one (1) year on all unpaid installments.
- 3. The owner of any property so assessed may, at any time prior to certification of the assessment to the county auditor, pay the whole of the assessment on such property, with interest accrued to the date of payment, to the city treasurer, except that no interest shall be charged if the entire assessment is paid within 30 days from the adoption of this resolution; and he/she may, at any time thereafter, pay to the city treasurer the entire amount of the assessment remaining unpaid, with interest accrued to December 31 of the year in which such payment is made. Such payment must be made before November 15 or interest will be charged through December 31 of the next succeeding year.
- 4. The City Clerk shall forthwith transmit a certified duplicate of this assessment to the County Auditor to be extended on the property tax lists of the county. Such assessments shall be collected and paid over in the same manner as other municipal taxes.

At the regular October council meeting, staff presented a letter that was submitted by Washington County indicating that the City's Individual Sewage Treatment System section of the City Code (Chapter 12, Environment, Article IV) was inconsistent with the County's regulations. Since the County currently administers the septic permitting process the City is required to have an ordinance/code which is consistent with the County's regulations and the State Rules. As such, after discussion, the Council determined that it would be most effective to repeal the majority of the Sections contained within the City's Current Code relating to ISTS and to simply incorporate the Washington County Regulations by reference.

Action Requested: Staff has prepared the attached Draft Ordinance 2016-48 which repeals most Sections of Chapter 12, Environment, Article IV Individual Sewage Treatment Systems, and incorporates the Washington County Regulations by reference.
